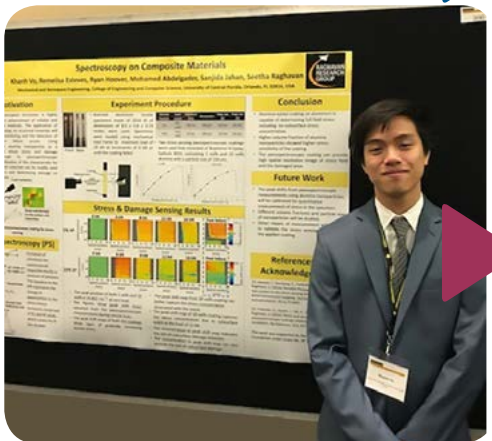

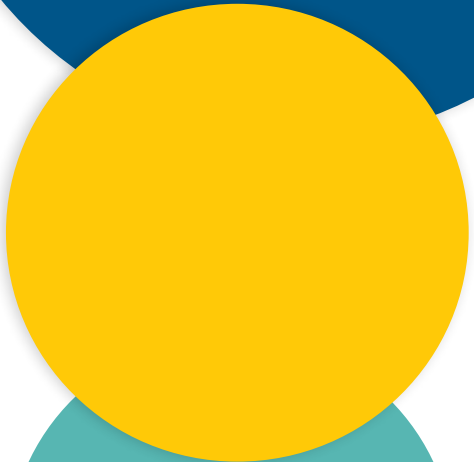
Register for The Leadership in Engineering Course
