

What courses can I take if I am Engineering Pending?

What courses will I have access to register for if I am currently enrolled in the final pending requirements?

Students who are in-progress of completing the final pending courses will be allowed access to a second tier of upper division courses necessary for progression in the major, in addition to other math and science prerequisites. Upon successful completion of the in-progress courses students will be changed from pending to the major.
