- Career Services helped 44,313 students search and compete for jobs in 2020-21.

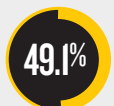
TOP VALUE EDUCATION

- Kiplinger and *Forbes* rank UCF among the nation's best education values.

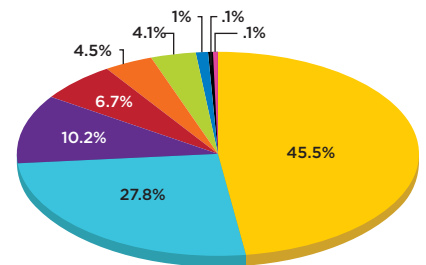


QUALITY AND DIVERSITY
